FOURTH BRAINSTORMING WEEK ON MEMBRANE COMPUTING

Sevilla, Spain

January 30 – February 3, 2006

- Similarly to the previous editions, the goal is to gather together researchers interested in membrane computing (theory and applications), for exchanging ideas, problems, solutions, for working together, in a friendly framework. Only short and provocative presentations will be scheduled in the first days, then the time will be mainly devoted to joint work. Those interested in having such presentations should inform the organizers some days before the meeting. The participants are strongly encouraged to circulate open problems and research proposals by internet (e.g., posting the problems in the Milano P page).
